Western Carolina Railway Service Corporation announced today that it has filed with the Surface Transportation Board an Offer of Financial Assistance to purchase 11.8 miles of rail line, extending from MP 0.0, in Greenville, SC, to MP 11.8, at the northern limits of Travelers Rest, SC, in Greenville County; that portion of STB Docket No. AB-490-1-X, proposed to be abandoned by Greenville County Economic Development Corporation.
