Greenville & Western Railway Company, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Western Carolina Railway Service Corporation, will be rebuilding the O'Neal Street rail-highway grade crossing May 7-9, 2012.

It is anticipated that the O'Neal Street crossing will be closed for approximately 60 hours, commencing the morning of May 7 and extending through the evening of May 9. During this brief road closure, motorists should use River Street (SC 247) as a detour route around the closed section of O'Neal Street between Williams Street (to the west) and Horton Avenue (to the east). O'Neal Street will remain open to local traffic on each side of the grade crossing between Williams Street and Horton Avenue.
